## CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin work in mid-August 2020 to improve the intersection at US 98/441 (SR 15/700) at SE 18th Terrace in Okeechobee County. The project consists of reconstructing the intersection to a roundabout, enhancing connectivity, circulation and safety. The project limits are identified below on the project location map.

## PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstruct the US 441/98 (SR 15/700) and SE 18th Terrace intersection to a roundabout
- Resurface US 441/98 (SR 15/700) and SE 18th Terrace
- Install street lights along US 441/98 (SR 15/700) near the roundabout
- Install curb and gutter, signage and pavement markers
- Estimated construction cost is \$1.3 million

- Construction begins mid-August; estimated completion is summer 2021
- Daytime and nighttime lane closures may occur during construction on US 441/98 (SR 15/700) and SE 18th Terrace Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., weather permitting
