

PD&E Study Complete

On **October 14, 2019**, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Office of Environmental Management (OEM) granted Location and Design Concept Acceptance for the Harborview Road (CR 776) Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study.

The project limits are from Melbourne Street to I-75 in the City of Port Charlotte, Charlotte County, Florida. The proposed improvements involve widening Harborview Road (CR 776) from the existing two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway. This improvement is necessary to provide additional capacity to accommodate future travel demand generated by projected population and economic growth in Port Charlotte and Charlotte County. This project is now eligible to move to the next phase of development, where construction plans will be prepared.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by the FDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2016, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration and FDOT.
