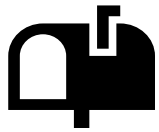

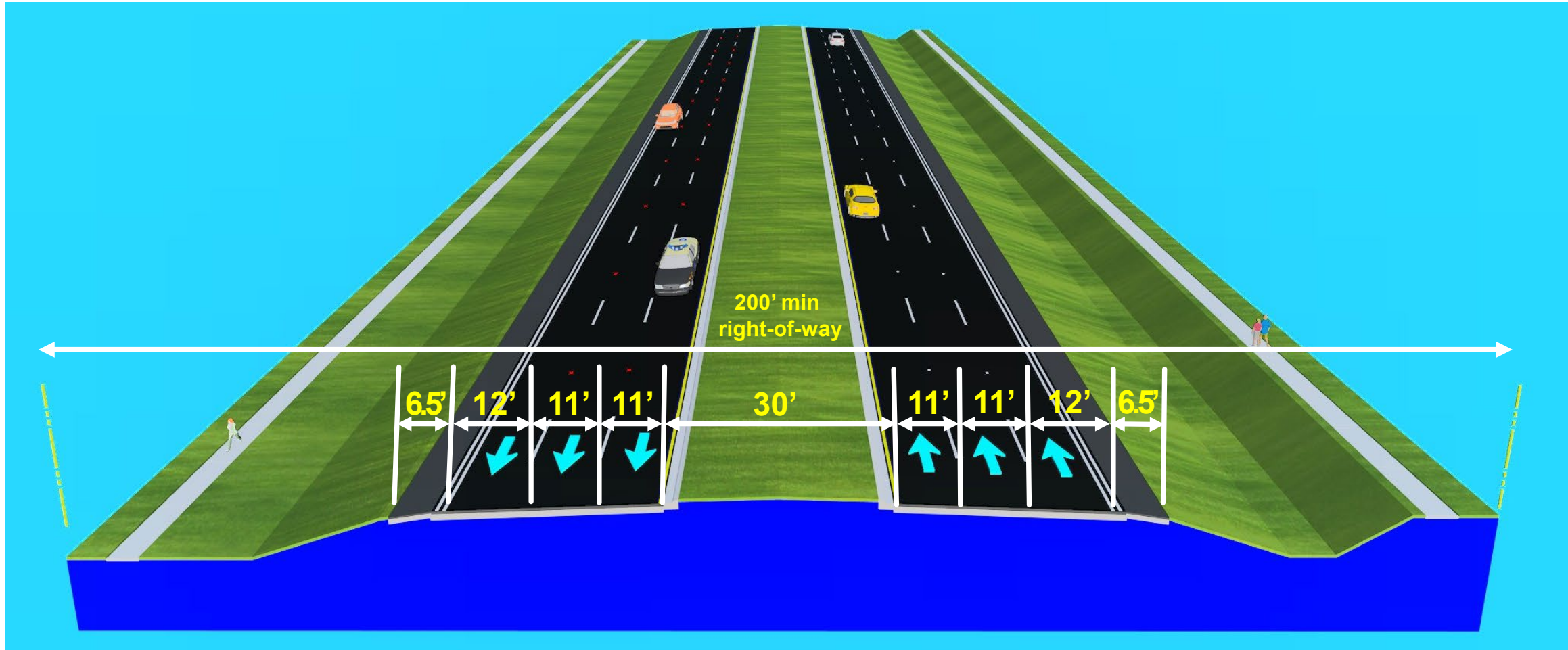


# Proposed Activities to Improve Safety and Mobility

- Reconfigure traffic patterns (signal and median modifications)
- Add features for pedestrians, bicyclists, and bus riders

## Intersections at Sanibel Blvd & at Constitution Blvd

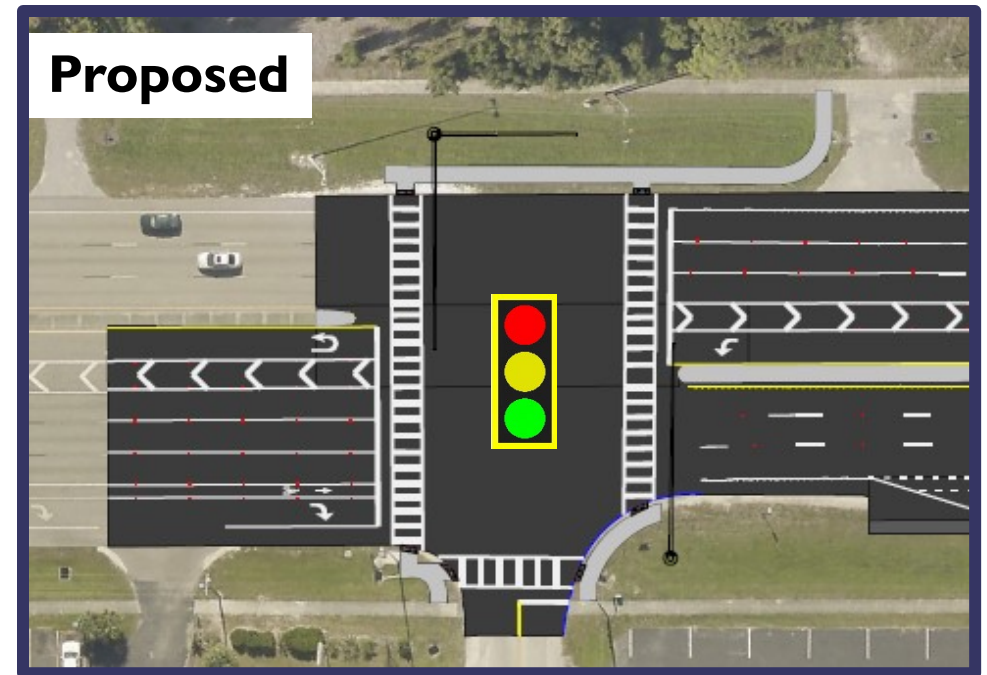
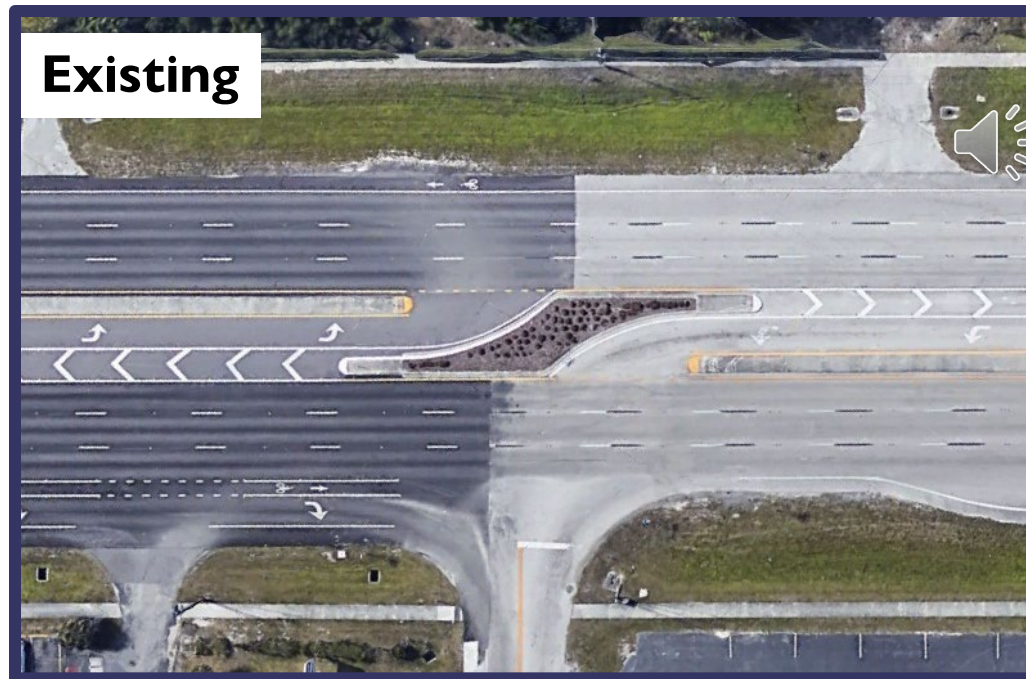
- New mast arms
- New signal heads with reflective backplates
- Additional 3-section signal heads
- Replace the 5-section signal head with a 4-section signal head
- Upgraded ADA-compliant pedestrian features
- New pedestrian crosswalk markings and lighting

## New Intersection at San Carlos Blvd

- Signal Warrant Study and Intersection Control Evaluation
- Recommendation: change the two-way directional median opening to a signalized intersection



# Bicycle Accommodations

## Lee MPO Bicyclist and Pedestrian Safety Action Plan

- Widen roadway shoulders
- Add bicycle lanes at the right turn lanes in each signalized intersection



## Balancing Access and Safety

- Access to properties increases the mobility of people and goods
- Openings for vehicles to enter/exit a roadway interrupt traffic flow and present conflicts
- Roadway features like medians and median openings can help to manage access to properties

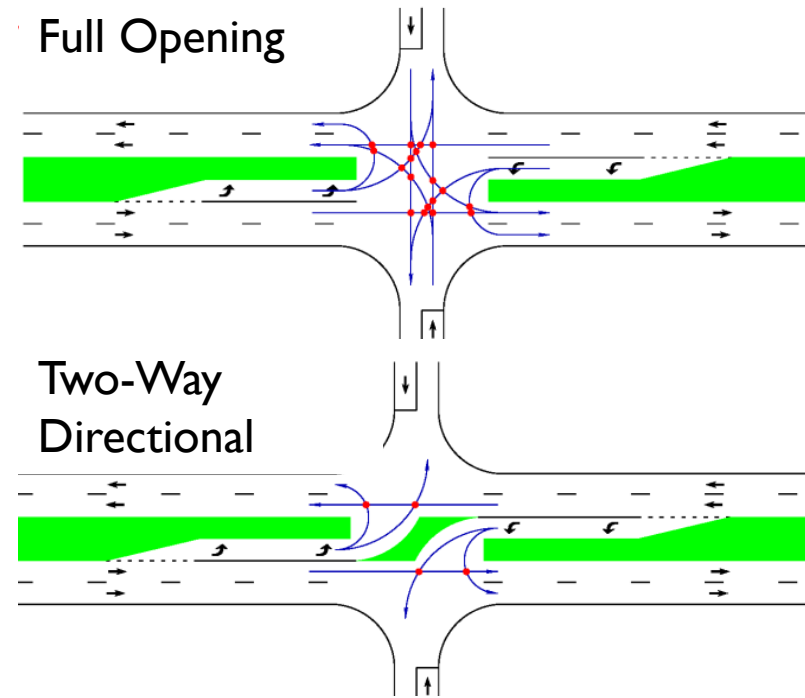


# Conflict Points

- Areas where paths legally cross within an intersection
- Reducing the number of conflict points increases safety

Full median openings have 18 major conflict points.

Two-way directional openings have 4.



U-turn compared to Left Turn

- 18% fewer crashes
- 27% reduction injury/fatality rate

# Managing Access through Median Openings



Drivers traveling in both directions share the space in a **full median opening** (above).

Drivers have a dedicated turning space separated from opposing traffic in a **directional median opening** (below).

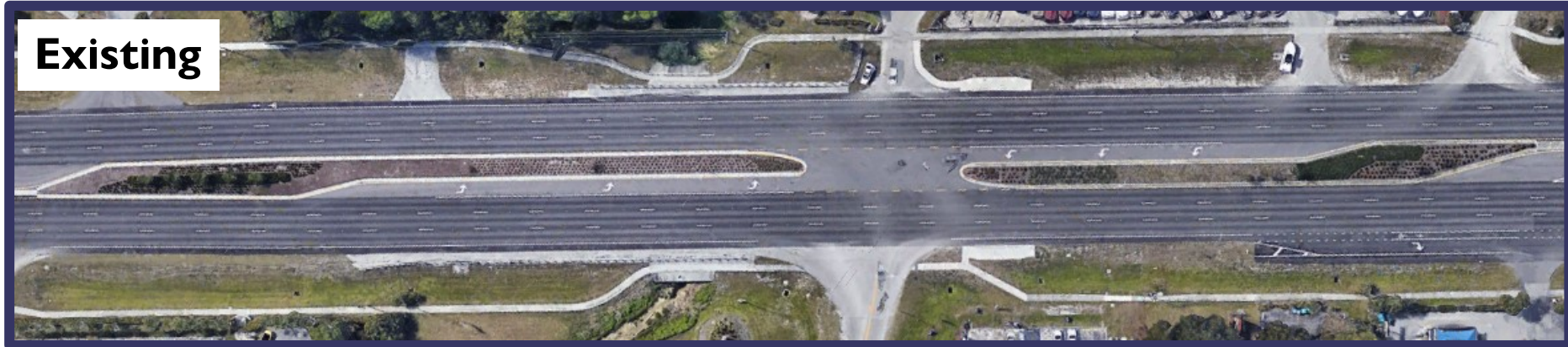


# Performance Predictions

- Hickory Drive: 30% reduction in crashes
- Emerson Square Boulevard: 43% reduction in crashes

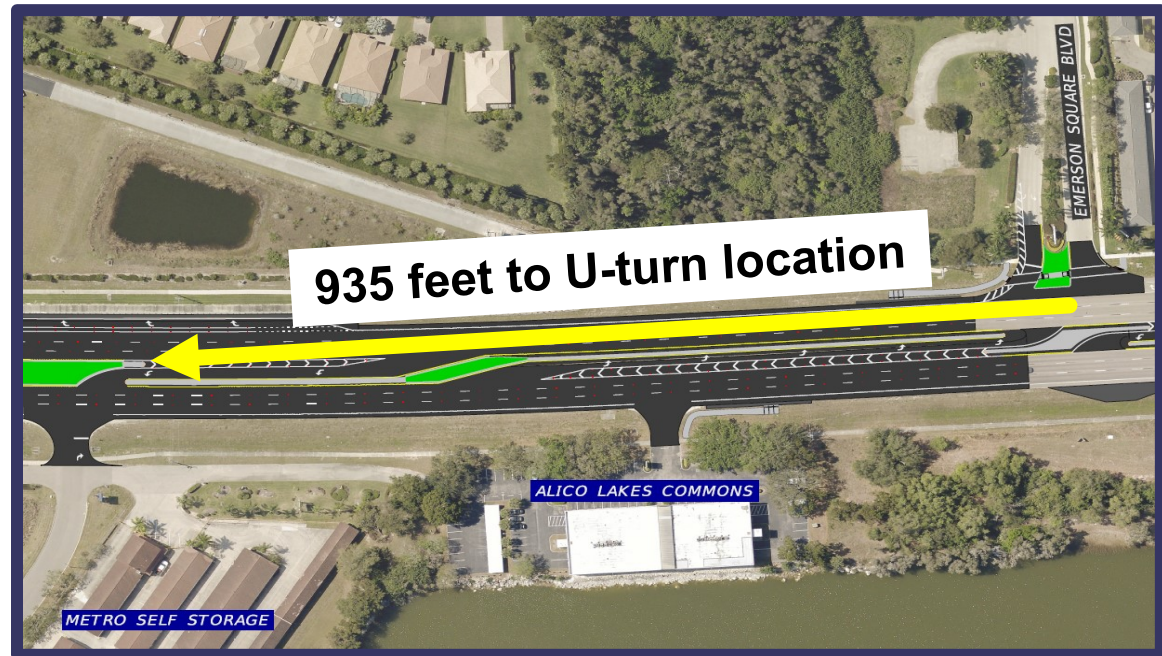

- 43% fewer crashes



## Additional Proposed Activities

- Add boarding areas and sidewalk connections at bus stop locations
- Shift sidewalks/crosswalks to the front of stop bars at side streets
