## Safety Statistics 2014 - 2018

- 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West intersection: 43 crashes (23 with serious injuries, 2 with fatalities)
- 26<sup>th</sup> Street West intersection: 51 crashes (29 with serious injuries, 1 with a fatality)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> highest priority "open median conversion" project in FDOT District 1

Re: Safety Concerns S.R. 45 and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West

Mayor Bryant,

I wanted to follow-up with you regarding our shared safety concerns about the intersection of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West and S.R. 45 (Business U.S. 41). This intersection continues to be one of the more dangerous intersections in the City of Palmetto, especially for drivers making left turns across the southbound lanes of S.R. 45. I believe that there are two basic reasons for this dangerous condition.

First, 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West is elevated and there is a down-hill slope as it graduates into S.R. 45. Drivers tell us that this slope makes it difficult to judge the speed of oncoming vehicles when making a left turn. Another problem is the speed of southbound traffic along S.R. 45. Southbound traffic enters the city from S.R. 55 and U.S. 19 (wide, high speed roadways) just north of the intersection with 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West and S.R. 45. When the traffic enters the city along S.R. 45, the posted speed limit is 50 MPH. As traffic passes the intersection in question, it is quickly stepped down from 50 MPH to 45 MPH, then immediately to 35 MPH (all within a two block radius). I submit that these posted speed limits are too fast (it should also be noted that this traffic is immediately feeding into Palmetto's downtown corridor). Compounding the problem, traffic approaching and passing the 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West intersection is often travelling much faster, as evidenced by the police department's frequent speed enforcement along this roadway.




## Phased Approach

- Short-term: temporary medians
  - Manage access to reduce angle and left-turn crashes
  - Could be installed as early as six months after the public hearing
- Long-term: permanent improvements
  - Roundabout at 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West
    - Restore access to northbound U.S. Business 41 from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West while continuing to reduce angle and left-turn crashes
    - Provide "U-turn" function for traffic wanting to travel north from 26<sup>th</sup> Street West
  - Raised median at 26<sup>th</sup> Street West intersection will continue to reduce angle and left-turn crashes




## Temporary Design Conditions – 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West




## Future (Permanent) Improvements

- Multi-lane roundabout at 23<sup>rd</sup> Street West
- Modifications at the intersection at 26<sup>th</sup> Street West/Bayshore Road from a full opening (with temporary median) to a directional opening
- Bicycle keyhole lanes in the right turn lanes at 26th Street West/Bayshore Road
- Milling and resurfacing from 17<sup>th</sup> Street West to north of 26<sup>th</sup> Street West/Bayshore Road
- Guardrail, driveway and ADA improvements, minor drainage improvements, pedestrian signal upgrades, lighting, signing, and pavement markings

## Project Schedule and Cost

- Project design: Fall 2020 through Spring 2021
- Installation of temporary medians: Summer 2021
- Cost of temporary medians: \$16,000

Note: installation of permanent improvements is anticipated in Summer 2023


