Safety Statistics 2014 - 2018


During Design, safety statistics showed:

- 23rd Street West intersection: 43 crashes (23 with serious injuries, 2 with fatalities)
- 26th Street West intersection: 51 crashes (29 with serious injuries, 1 with a fatality)
- 2nd highest priority "median conversion" project FDOT District 1

- Expect noise from back-up alarms, trucks, and construction equipment.




