

# State Road 31 PD&E Study

North of North River Road (County Road (CR) 78) in Lee County to North of Cook Brown Road in Charlotte County

#### INTRODUCTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, is assisting in the development of a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study to evaluate the potential widening of State Road (SR) 31 from north of North River Road (County Road (CR) 78) in Lee County to north of Cook Brown Road in Charlotte County, Florida. The total project length is approximately 4 miles.



### STUDY OVERVIEW

FDOT, District One, is assisting in the development of a PD&E study to determine the location and conceptual design of the preferred roadway improvements and the associated social, cultural, economic, natural and physical effects of the improvements. The alternatives considered involve the potential widening of the existing two-lane undivided roadway and the addition of bicycle and pedestrian facilities. The expansion of SR 31 is anticipated to improve overall safety, emergency access and truck access, and accommodate future growth in the area. The no-build alternative will remain an option throughout the study.

#### WHAT IS A PD&E STUDY?

A PD&E study is an environmental and engineering process developed by FDOT to determine social, cultural, economic. natural and physical effects associated with a proposed transportation improvement project. The process requires the combined efforts of professional engineers, planners, and scientists who collect and analyze project-related information to develop the best solution for transportation needs. An important part of the study is public involvement and coordination with agencies. The process used in the development of the project is made up of several components. These include:

- Data Collection
- •Alternatives Analysis (including the no-build alternative)
- Selection of preferred alternative(s)
- Public and agency involvement

#### WHATS NEXT?


