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Work begins in mid-October on a Florida Department of Transportation project in Bradley Junction to reconstruct SR 37 using a process known as full depth reclamation (FDR). FDR cuts through the asphalt section of the roadway and into the underlying base to remove deep pavement cracks. The ground up material is then reused to make a new roadway. Improvements under this project include:

- Grinding out the full depth of the old roadway into the base
- Combining the recycled ground material along with a cement mix to make a new roadway base
- Placing a new asphalt layer on top of the recycled base
- Reconstructing the roadway shoulders
- Modifying the signal at CR 640 (Pinecrest Road)

Lane Closure Information

- Watch for extended daytime and nighttime lane closures resulting in one-way traffic controlled with flaggers and/or temporary signals.
- When exiting driveways and side streets into a lane closure, wait for traffic to pass in the direction you want to travel before entering the roadway.
- Use caution, be prepared to stop and expect delays.
