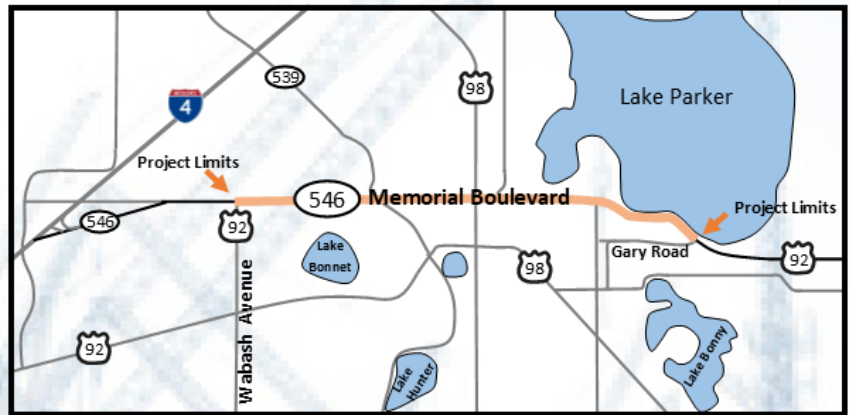
CONSTRUCTION PROJECT



The Florida Department of Transportation began repairing the concrete slabs on US 92/State Road 546 (Memorial Boulevard) in Polk County in February 2019. The project limits are from Wabash Avenue to East Gary Road, approximately four miles. The project limits are identified on the map below.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Concrete pavement repairs
- Intersection modification and paving at Martin L King Jr. Avenue
- Four new High Intensity Activated Crosswalks (HAWK) signals*
- Median safety improvements
- Upgraded street lighting
- New pavement markings
- Sidewalk repairs

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction began February 18, 2019 and ends in early 2020, weather permitting.
- Crews may be working during the daytime and nighttime.
- Watch for possible single daytime lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and overnight lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. on US 92. No restrictions on Martin L King Jr. Avenue.
- Please be alert for construction crews.
- Construction costs are estimated at \$4.9 million.

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HAWK SIGNALS ON SR 546 MEMORIAL BOULEVARD

High Intensity Activated Crosswalk Signals (HAWK) are being placed in four locations on Memorial Boulevard to assist pedestrians with safely crossing the roadway. When a pedestrian pushes the crosswalk button, the signals activate to stop traffic and allow the pedestrian to cross the road. The signals remain dark when there are no pedestrians crossing.

- Kettles Avenue
- Stella Avenue
- West of Vermont Avenue
- Morgan Avenue
