US 41 from Salford Boulevard to Sumter Boulevard

Roadway Improvement Project

The Florida Department of Transportation along with its contractor, Russell Engineering, Inc., are making improvements to US 41 from Salford Boulevard to Sumter Boulevard in North Port. Improvements include widening US 41 to six-lane highway, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, improving drainage, constructing sidewalk, installing highway lighting, and new signing and pavement markings.

The \$10.1 million project begins late June/early July. Expected completion is spring 2019.

Lane Closures

Motorists should expect nighttime/overnight lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. when crews are resurfacing the roadway.

Nighttime/overnight lane closures from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. within 600 feet of a signalized intersection are to be expected when crews are resurfacing the roadway.

Motorists should obey the posted speed limit and use caution while driving through the construction zone.
