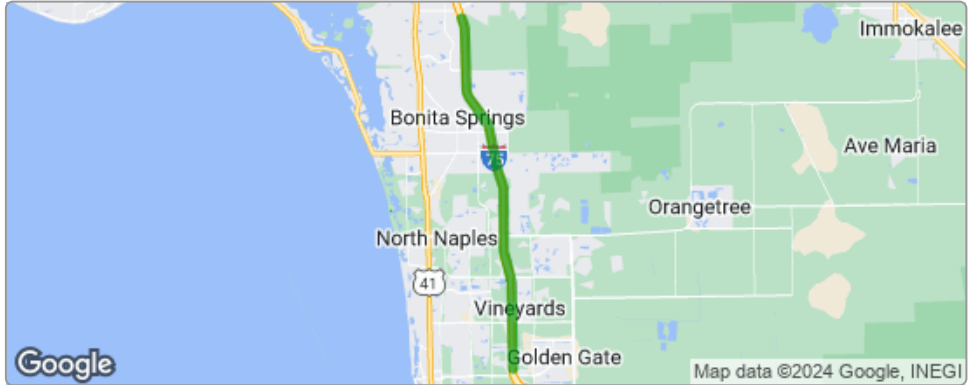

This project only includes widening I-75. There would be no improvements to the interchanges, except for ramp modifications.</p>
