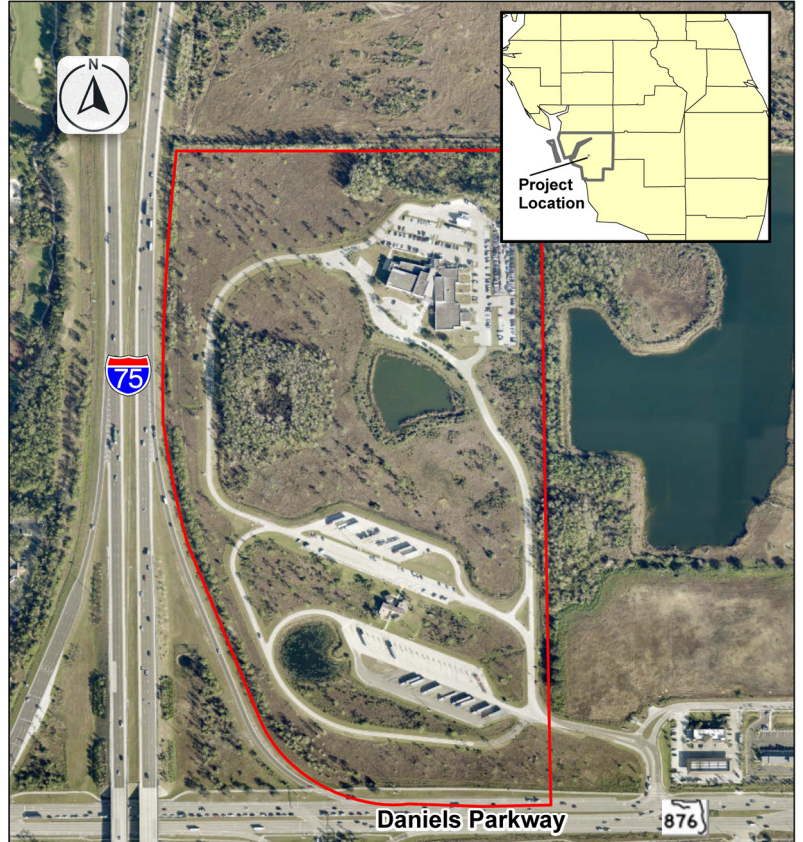
## WELCOME TO THE PUBLIC OUTREACH MEETING

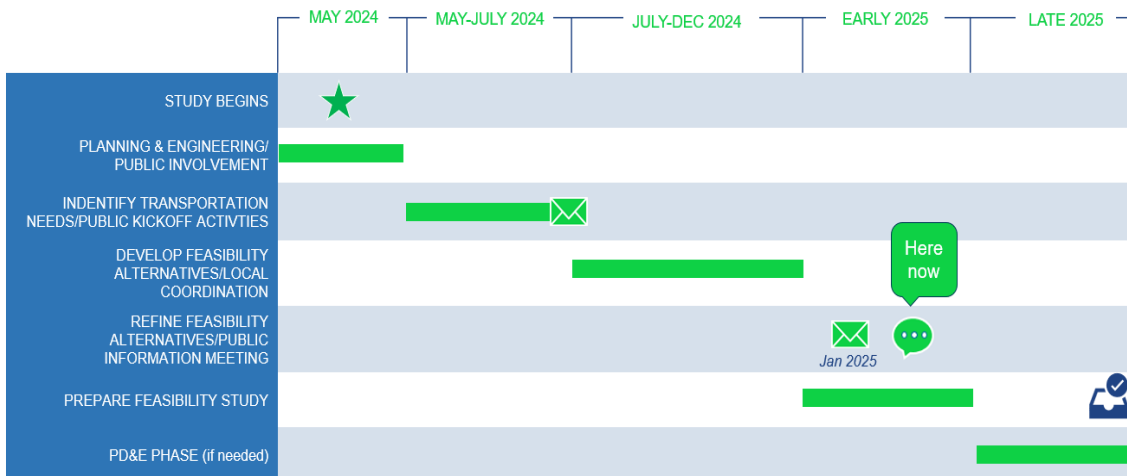
