CONSTRUCTION PROJECT


The Florida Department of Transportation expects to begin work milling and resurfacing SR 66 from US 17 (SR 35) to Charlie Creek on August 15, 2024. The project limits encompass approximately 7.8 miles and crews will also install drainage pipes and structures, guardrail, sidewalks, new signage, curb and gutter, pavement markings and other safety improvements. The project will be completed in phases, with one of the phases encompassing a closure of westbound SR 66 from Merle Langford Road to US 17 for several months. (Please see reverse side for map.)

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing
- New signage and pavement markings
- Addition of curb, gutter and sidewalks in the Town of Zolfo Springs
- Installation of pedestrian safety features
- Guardrail replacement
- New drainage pipes and structures
- Estimated construction cost is \$13.2 million

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins August 15, 2024; estimated completion is early 2026
- During construction on the east end of the project there may be daytime/ nighttime lane closures when traffic will be reduced to one lane
- During construction on the west end of the project, westbound SR 66 will be closed from Merle Langford Road to US 17. Traffic will be detoured north to Steve Roberts Special and then to SR 64 to access US 17
