

SR 777 (RIVER ROAD) PD&E STUDY REEVALUATION FROM CENTER ROAD TO SOUTH OF 1-75 **PUBLIC HEARING**

REEVALUATION PURPOSE

The Florida Department of Transportation is conducting a public hearing for the State Road (SR) 777 (River Road) from Center Road to south of Interstate 75 (I-75) Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study Reevaluation. A PD&E Study was previously completed for River Road from US 41 to south of I-75 in 2004 by Sarasota County. This original PD&E Study included two segments: Segment 1 from US 41 to Center Road and Segment 2 from Center Road to just south of I-75. This PD&E Study was followed by a 2008 design change and right-of-way (ROW) reauthorization reevaluation which was approved by the Federal Highway Administration. Construction began on the section of River Road from US 41 to Center Road in February 2022 and includes widening from two lanes to six lanes.

FDOT District One determined that widening River Road from Center Road to south of I-75 from two lanes to six lanes will meet travel demand and enhance safety along this section of the roadway. To re-design this section of River Road, federal and state regulations require a PD&E Study Reevaluation to determine if any additional environmental impacts would result from the additional travel lanes and related project improvements.


This reevaluation will evaluate and document any changes in impacts to affected resources (social, cultural, natural, and physical), as well as any new impacts to resources. Proposed improvements include widening from two lanes to six lanes, a shared use path on both sides of River Road, two wildlife crossings, lighting, signalization, and stormwater management facilities.



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


All comments postmarked, emailed, or submitted through the website on or before December 2, 2024, will become part of the public hearing record.

TYPICAL SECTION

- Additional two lanes will be to the inside towards the center median
- Includes two 10-foot-wide shared use paths
- Provides open ditches between the roadway and shared use path
- Provides street lighting in designated locations
