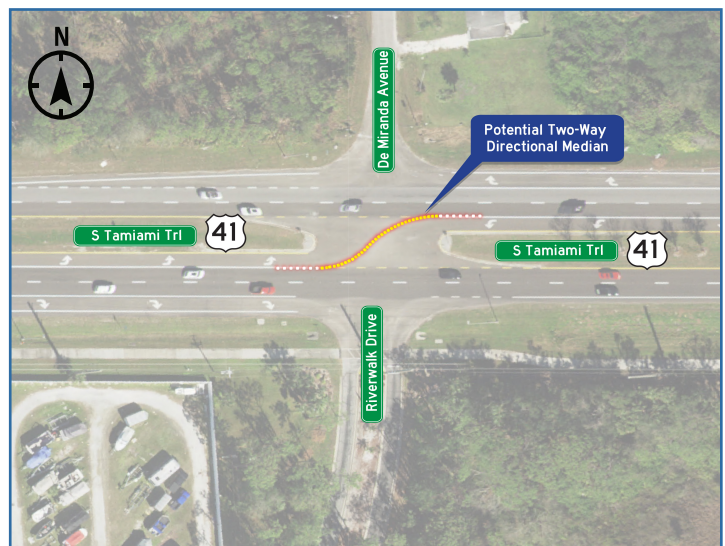
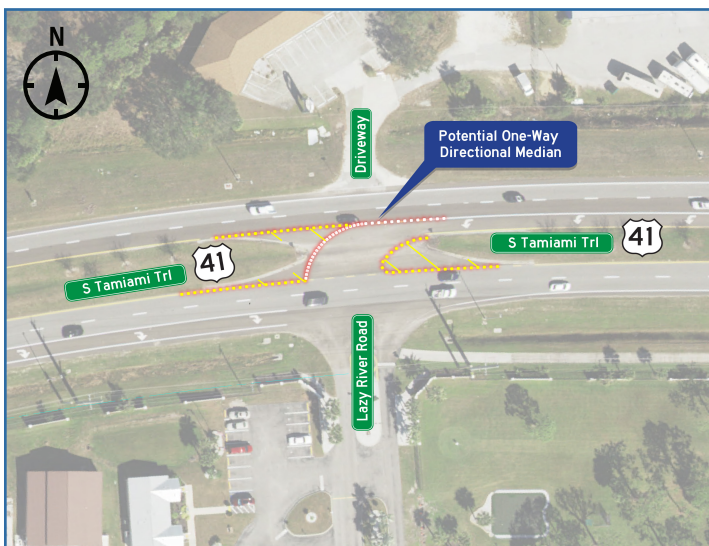
The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, welcomes you to the Public Meeting for the US 41 North Port Safety Improvements project. PROJECT OVERVIEW


FDOT, District One, is considering improvements at several intersections along US 41 in Sarasota County. The purpose of the improvements is to improve safety, enhance traffic flow, and reduce crashes. The potential improvements include converting existing full median openings into directional median openings at six (6) intersections along the corridor: Lazy River Road, Riverwalk Drive/De Miranda Avenue, De Leon Drive, Palm Harbor Drive, Blackburn Boulevard/Ortega Place, and El Prado Avenue. Additional improvements include constructing a southbound left turn lane at El Prado Avenue and lengthening the southbound left turn lane at Ortiz Boulevard.

This meeting is being held to present project information and provide an opportunity for the public to offer feedback. FDOT will accept written comments during and after the meeting. Please submit your comments by April 11, 2025, to be included in the formal public meeting record.
